Bridging Program for Masters of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Planning, Planning (Urban Design) and Design in Digital Media

The Faculty of the Professions in association with the School of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Urban Design will run a bridging program for all postgraduate by coursework students entering the new Masters programs in 2008.

The Master's Bridging Program will be held during the two weeks before the commencement of Semester 1, between 18-29 February 2008. In addition to those sessions run by the School of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Urban Design, some sessions will be run by the Faculty of Professions learning support. All these sessions will be held in the School of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Urban Design.

Week One, from 18 – 22 February, is mandatory for all new International students and will be integrated with the 2008 International Student Centre Orientation Program. In addition to sessions covering academic topics, students may choose to participate in workshops on many aspects of living and studying in Adelaide and other social activities.

Week Two, from 25 – 29 February, is mandatory for all post-graduate students entering the Masters degrees.
