(1) - The Seminar (15035) has 168 spots allocated with 19 free spots for enrolment.

The dates for the seminar are on 1) 29 Feb (Mon) to 4 Apr (Mon) / 2) 25 Apr to 25 Apr and 3) 30 May to 30 May (***note this on your weekly timetable on Access Adelaide**).

(2) - The Lecture (12511) starts on 1 Mar (Tue) to 5 Apr and resumes from 26 Apr to 7 Jun, it has 168 spots allocated with 19 free spots for enrolment.

(3) – The Tutorials (12512 and 12513) have 84 spots each allocated with 8 and 11 free spots for enrolment respectively. The dates are from Mon 2 May to 23 May.

(1) - The Seminar (24832) has 195 spots allocated with 36 free spots for enrolment.

It starts on 25 Jul (Mon) to 12 Sep (Mon) and resumes 03 Oct (Mon) to 24 Oct (Mon) = 2 weeks break.

(2) - The Workshop in Group 1 (22260) starts on 25 Aug (Thu) and finishes on 15 Sep (Thu) and has 39 spots allocated with 6 free spots for enrolment.

(3) - The Tutorial in Group 1 (22255) has 39 spots allocated with 6 free spots for enrolment.

It starts on 28 Jul (Thu) to 18 Aug (Thu) and resumes on 6 Oct (Thu) to 27 Oct (Thu) **in two rooms both Barr Smith South 511 South and BSS 528 East. The Course Coordinator will split the groups over the two rooms.**

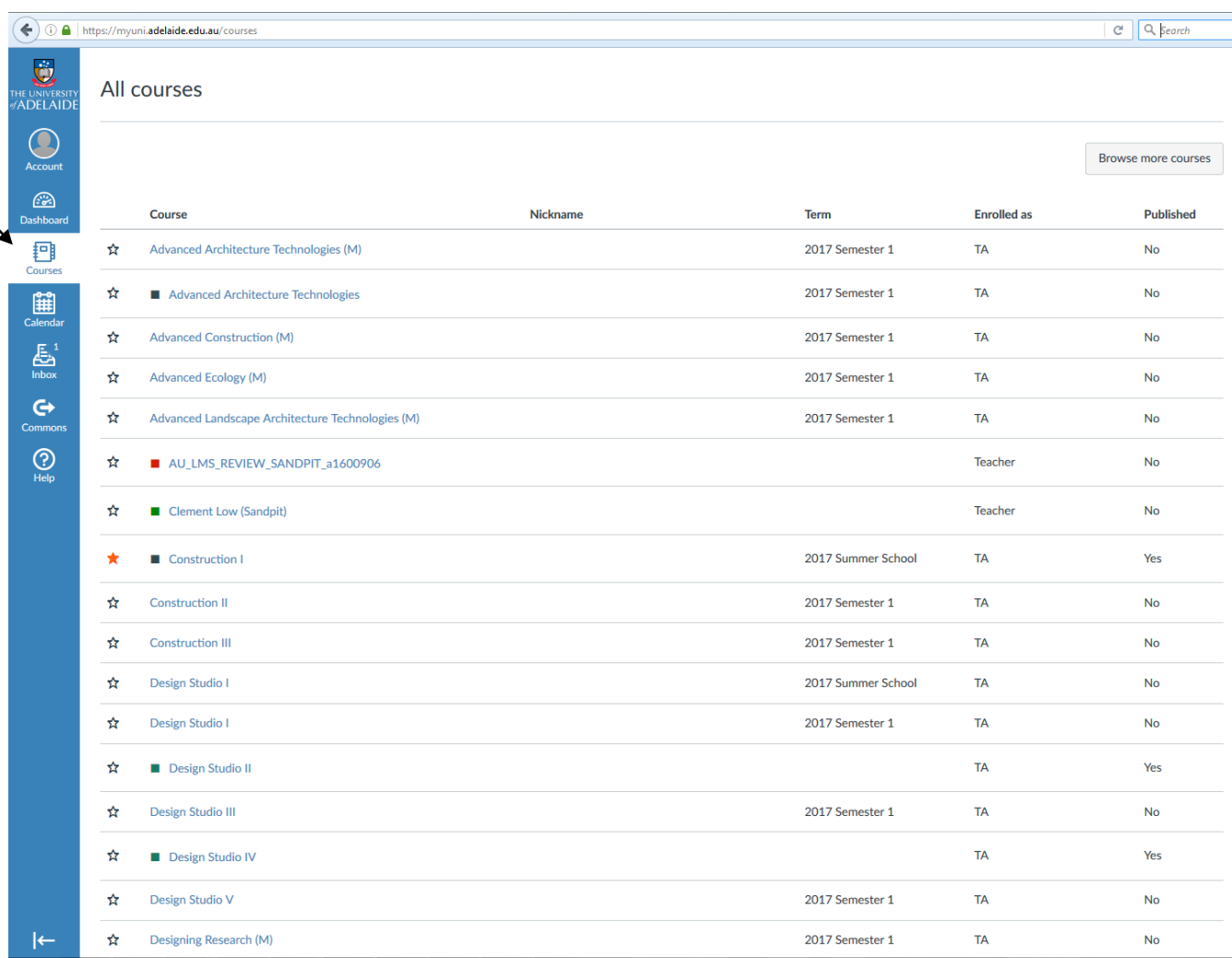
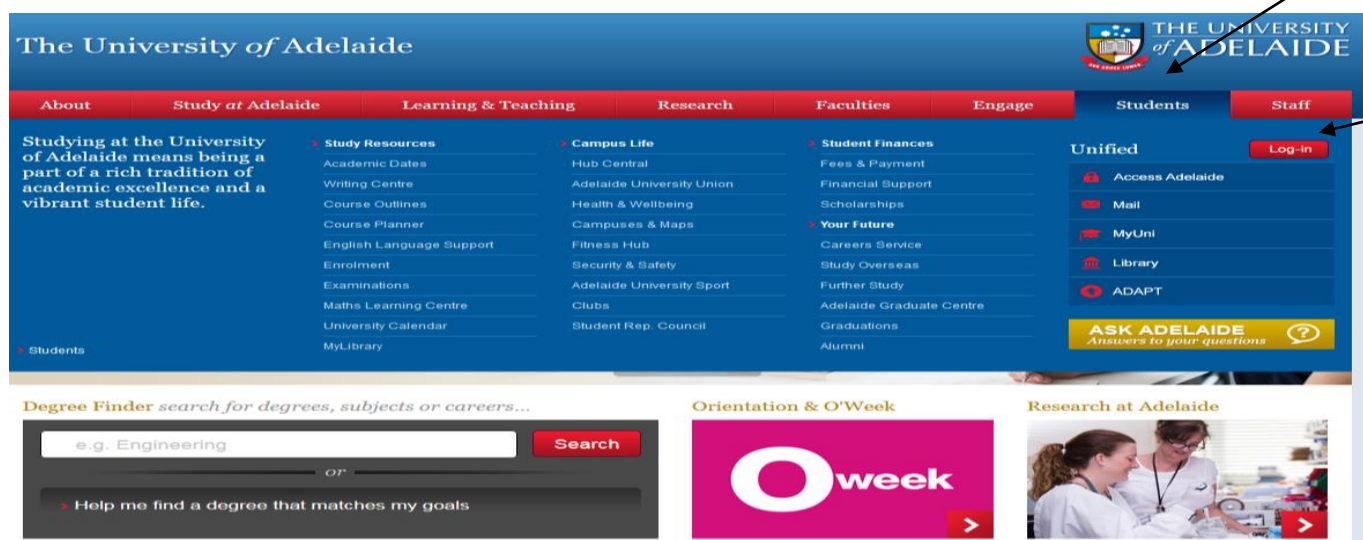
